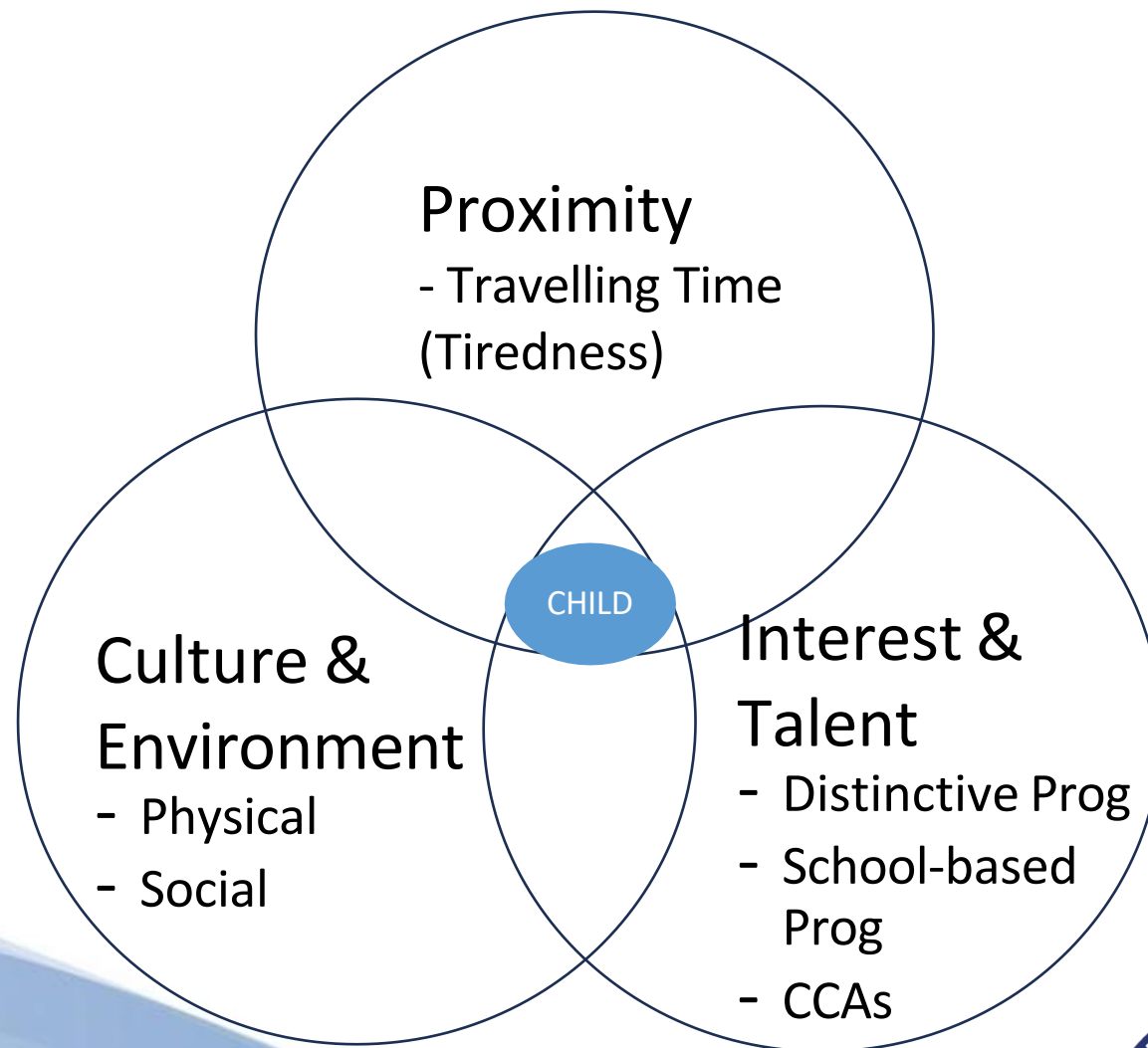

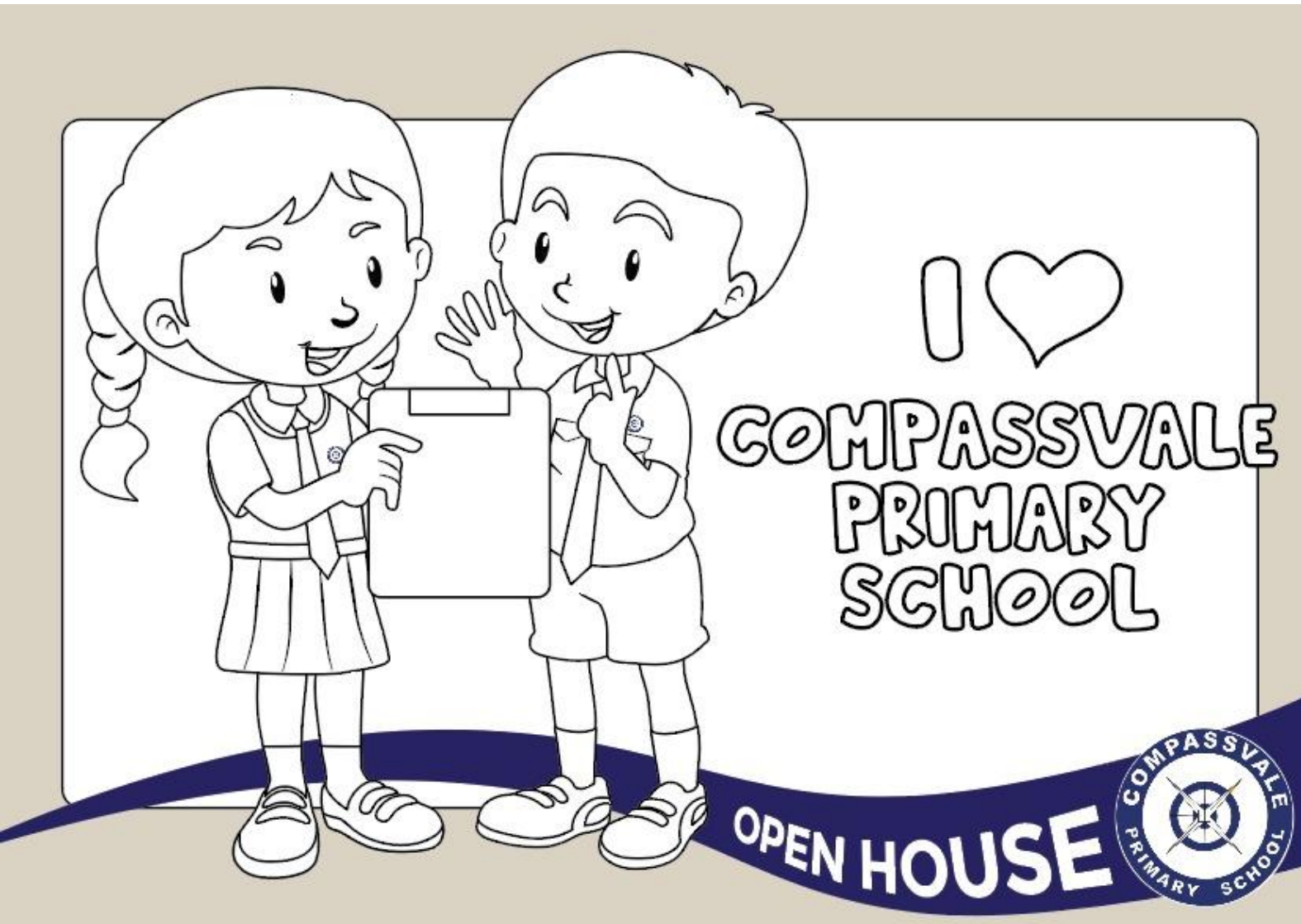

Designated Centers for After-School Modules

Update (March 2026):

- **MOE has announced that the Gifted Education Programme (GEP) will be discontinued in its current form. The last batch of GEP students will complete the programme in 2028.**
- **From 2027, a refreshed approach replaces the GEP — students stay at their own schools and access school-based provisions and advanced modules at 15 designated centres across Singapore.**
- **MOE has selected these 15 primary schools due to their geographic spread and public transport accessibility.**
- **More information will be given to parents at our P3 cohort briefing.**
